## Improve Cancer Screening Rates & Survivorship Care



**WHAT?** KanSurvive 2.0 is an NIH-funded study comparing different practice-based strategies to improve the delivery of cancer survivorship care in rural Primary Care Practice.

**WHY?** We are conducting this study because cancer survivors experience a higher risk of negative health outcomes, especially those who live in rural communities.

Evidence is needed to inform practical strategies to promote high-quality, evidence-based care for rural adult cancer survivors in the primary care setting.

**HOW?** Outcomes will be monitored for 24-months via electronic health record data transfer.

### Practices will...

- ▶ Implement a Quality Improvement protocol
- ▶ Use one of 3 approaches (random assignment) to improve the delivery of cancer survivorship care
- ▶ Map current survivorship care workflows
- ▶ Identify a clinic Implementation Team comprised of a Provider Practice Champion and Staff Lead
- ▶ Convene Implementation Team monthly for 12 months
- ▶ Collect EHR data at baseline, 6, 12, & 24 months
